### **Dr Alimi Abdul-Razaq, Federal Commissioner in charge of Legal, Licensing and Enforcement at the Nigerian Electricity Regulatory Commission.**

Dr Abdul-Razaq has been a Barrister and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Nigeria for thirty Years and is presently a Federal Commissioner in charge of Legal, Licensing and Enforcement at the Nigerian Electricity Regulatory Commission. Before assuming the position of Commissioner, he was the Managing Partner at A. Abdul-Razaq (SAN) & Co a law firm in Nigeria between 1986 and 2005. Dr Abdul-Razaq is also a member of the Royal Institute of International Affairs, London. He was also the Chairman of the National Iron Ore Mining Co. Itakpe from 1999 until its privatisation in 2004 and was appointed to the Presidential Advisory Committee on defence and security in 1999.

Dr Abdul Razaq was a member of the Legal Study Team that drafted the legal framework for the privatisation and commercialisation of Nigerian public enterprises in 1985, and was also the co-founder and first Executive Secretary of the Nigerian Council for Human Rights (NCHR).
