Dr. Mark Abani is the head of The Central Association of Nigerians in the United Kingdom (CANUK), an umbrella body of all Nigerian Associations in the United Kingdom and Northern Ireland. It currently represents about 45 different associations and 18 other affiliate/associate members with a take-off membership of 28,000.
